Navigational Limit QC-1

The Inland and Coastal waters of Quebec South of 52 degrees latitude.

The Ottawa River and the St. Lawrence River between the Western boundary starting at Wolfe Island, ending at direct line between Baie-Comeau and Matane on the St. Lawrence as the Eastern boundary limit. The Inland waters of New Brunswick and bordering lakes and rivers between Quebec and Ontario. The Inland waters of US States of Vermont, Maine, New Hampshire, Massachusetts, Connecticut, Rhode Island and New York, north of 40 degrees north latitude excluding the Hudson River, below the Tappan Zee bridge and excluding New York Harbour. Coastal waters being within 100 miles of mainland.

Form #OC-1 (rev. December 19, 2016) Navigational Limit ON-1

The Great Lakes and their tributaries. The inland lakes and the Interior waters of Ontario, including Georgian Bay. The St. Lawrence River but not east of Quebec City. The waters of the States of Minnesota, Wisconsin, Michigan, Ohio, Pennsylvania and Vermont. The inland waters of New York State excluding New York Harbour and the Hudson River below the Tappan Zee Bridge.

Form #EC-1 (rev. December 19, 2016)
Navigational Limit EC-1

Canadian Inland navigable waterways and the Coastal waters of Newfoundland, Prince Edward Island, Nova Scotia, New Brunswick and Quebec, South of 52 Degrees Latitude. Also all United States navigable inland and coastal waterways east of 95 degrees longitude and north of 40 degrees north latitude (excluding New York Harbour and the Hudson River below the Tappen Zee Bridge). Coastal waters being within 100 miles of mainland.
